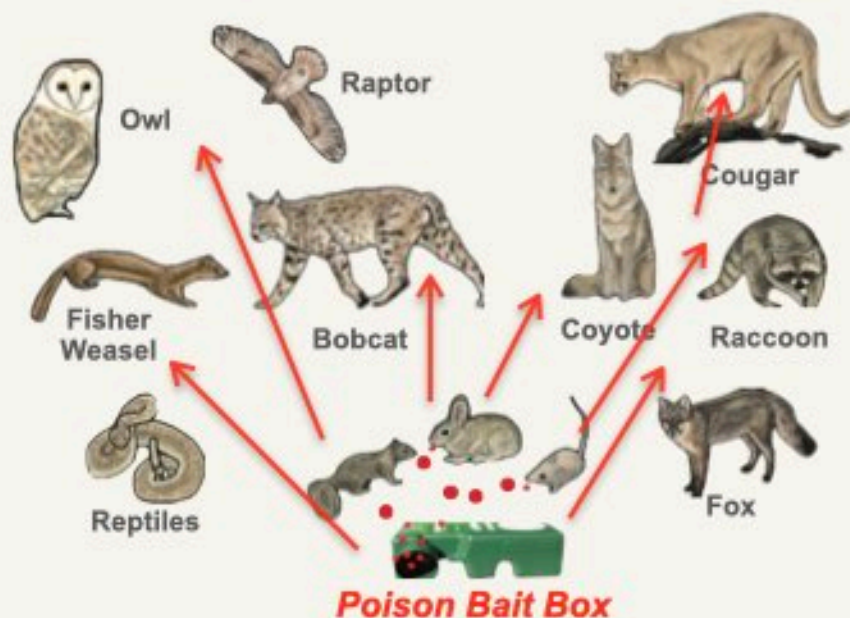
WHEN WE USE RODENT POISONS,
WE PUT PREDATORS, SCAVENGERS,
AND THE ENTIRE ECOSYSTEM AT RISK.
LET'S KEEP OUR CROSSING SAFE FOR
ALL WHO DEPEND ON IT.



THESE BAIT BOXES CONTAIN
RODENT POISONS WITH
SEVERE IMPACT ON WILDLIFE

POISONED RODENTS DO NOT DIE IN THE BOXES THEY LEAVE AND ARE EASILY CAUGHT BY PREDATORS

THE POISONS ARE PASSED UP THE FOOD CHAIN
Harming and killing our wildlife, pets, and even children.



THE FACTS ARE ALARMING:

- 10 of 16 mountain lions tested in the Santa Monica Mountains had bromethalin exposure (National Park Service, 2020–2022).
- Even small amounts of cholecalciferol can be deadly.
- Veterinarians report increasing cases of pet poisonings.

SAFE POISON

MOST COMMONLY USED NON-ANTICOAGULANT RAT POISONS:

- ☠ Bromethalin
- ☠ Cholecalciferol (Vitamin D₃)
- ☠ Strychnine
- ☠ Zinc Phosphide

**THERE ARE NO ANTIDOTES
FOR THESE POISONS!**

Bromethalin, cholecalciferol, and the others are highly toxic poisons to wildlife and pets, including predators and scavengers. The poisons' effects are rapid, irreversible, and deadly.

WE CAN DO BETTER. HERE'S HOW:



Seal entry points and remove harborage.



Eliminate food and water sources.



Use live traps or other non-lethal methods.



Share this information with neighbors and HOAs.
